CORPA RECOGNITION

The Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) was notified on September 14, 1995 that the Commission on Recognition of Postsecondary Accreditation (CORPA) granted continued recognition of the JRCNMT for a period of five years. This is as a free-standing agency with the scope of recognition as the accreditation of postsecondary certificate and degree programs in nuclear medicine technology.

1996 WORKSHOPS

Prior to the SNM and SNM-TS annual meeting in Denver, the JRCNMT will conduct workshops on Sunday, June 2

and Saturday, June 8 at the ASRT annual meeting in Louisville, KY. The format for the workshops will be an open forum regarding the revision of the *Essentials and Guidelines for an Accredited Educational Program for the Nuclear Medicine Technologist*. The focus of the forums will be on: (a) the conversion of all criteria to an outcome format; (b) an update of the curriculum standards; and (c) assessment criteria.
