USDE RECOGNITION

The Joint Review Committee on Education Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) was notified February 1, 1996 that the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education (USDE) renewed the recognition of the Review Committee for a period of four vears. Concurring with the recommendation of the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity, Secretary Riley noted that the JRCNMT will continue to be listed as a nationally recognized accreditation agency for accreditation throughout the U.S. of higher education programs for the nuclear medicine technologist. The JRC-NMT presently recognizes 118 programs with 618 affiliates throughout the U.S. and its possessions.
