

## MEETINGS

**T**he JRCNMT held its semiannual meeting on October 22–23, 2004, in Oak Brook, IL. During the meeting the Board of Directors took the following actions:

1) Approved personnel changes at 16 programs, program changes at 7 programs, and denied program changes at 5 programs;

2) Considered 4 follow-up reports, one midcycle report, and 17 progress reports from accredited programs;

3) Granted recognition to 57 new clinical affiliates;

4) Granted extended accreditation to 7 programs;

5) Granted Voluntary Withdrawal of Accreditation to the Oregon Institute of Technology, Klamath Falls, OR;

6) Granted Administrative Probationary Accreditation to Broward Community College, Coconut Creek, FL, with a resurvey date of 2005; and

Third-party testimony, written and oral, must be limited to the educational program's compliance with the *Essentials and Guidelines for an Accredited Educational Program for the Nuclear Medicine Technologist*.
